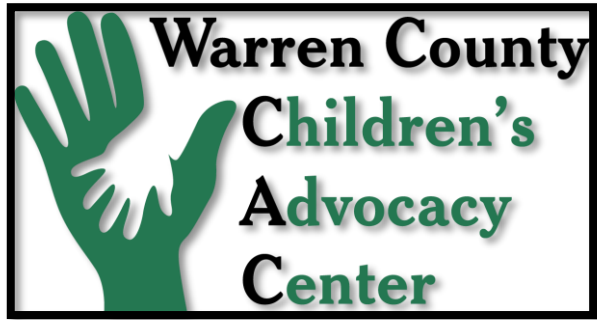

The Warren County CAC is a place for you to talk.

Adults listen.

The Warren County CAC is a safe place.



This is the parking lot that the adult that brought you will park in.

The door to the building is in the center of this picture.

The Warren County CAC is a safe place.



There is a doorbell to ring at the front door. The adult you came with will push it. It makes a loud “buzzing” noise.

There is a speaker on the doorbell. A person inside will say, “Hi, may I help you?” They may ask you your name.

That same person will let you and your adult in.

You are entering a safe space.





You will walk into the entry.

You will hear a “click” when the person inside unlocks the door.

The entry is a safe place.



When you come into the building, you might notice that the adults are covering their nose and mouth with a mask. This is to help keep everyone healthy.


The adult at the Warren County CAC may ask you to put a mask over your nose and mouth. If you do not have one, they will give you one.

You are entering a safe space.



You will walk into the lobby.



 You will check in at this "Welcome" desk.

The lobby is a safe place.

You will walk down this hallway. The “Family Room” is through the door on the right.

The adult that brought you will stay with you.

The hallway is a safe place.



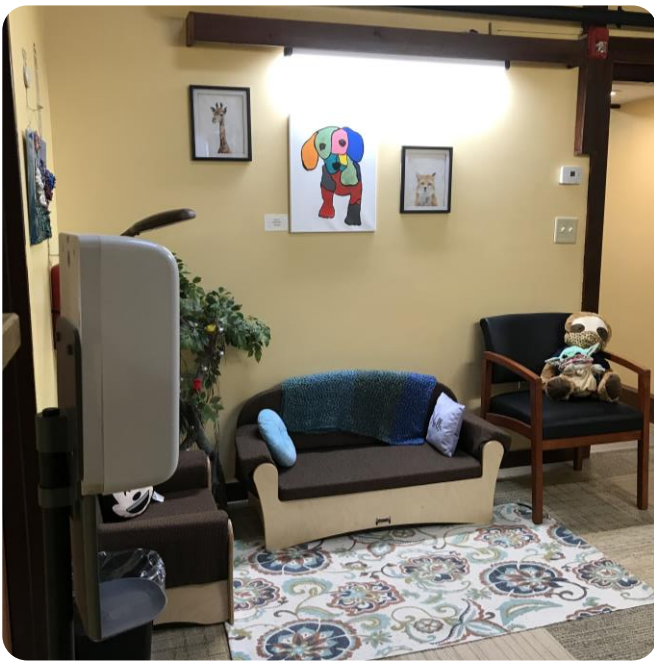
You will wait in the "Family Room." There are toys, books, and chairs there. You can read, play, and relax while you wait.

The adult you came with will fill out paperwork. There are snacks and drinks if you want them.

You will meet some adults that work at the Warren County CAC.

The "Family Room" is a safe place.





The adult you came with might need to talk to staff alone for a few minutes. There is a separate waiting area for you. It has books, toys, and chairs. You can read, play, or relax.



You may always ask to see the adult you came with.

The waiting area is a safe place.





When everyone is ready, you will go through this door with an adult that works at the Warren County CAC.



The adult that brought you will stay in the "Family Room."

This room is a safe space.

You will sit on the chair. The adult at the Warren County CAC will sit on the couch.

The adult will listen to you. They will get to know you and ask questions. This is called an interview.

This room is a safe place.



You will talk to the Warren County CAC adult by yourself. You can say anything to the CAC adult in the interview. It is important to tell the truth. You can take a break at any time. You can ask the adult questions.

In this room, you can use whatever words you need to use to help the adult understand.

This room is a safe place.

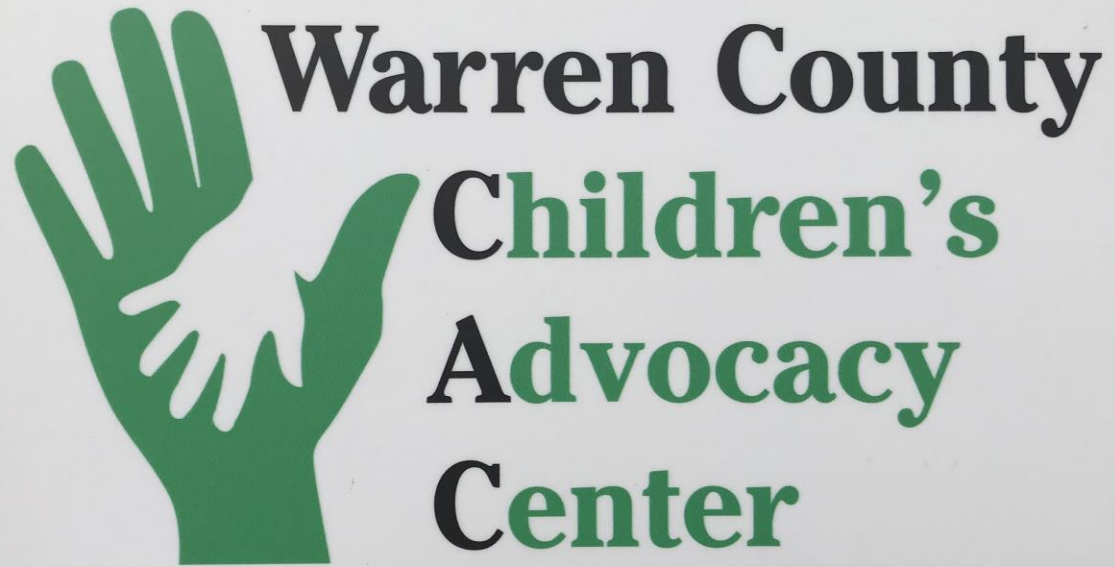




You might play again in the waiting area after your interview.

The adults will talk in a different room.

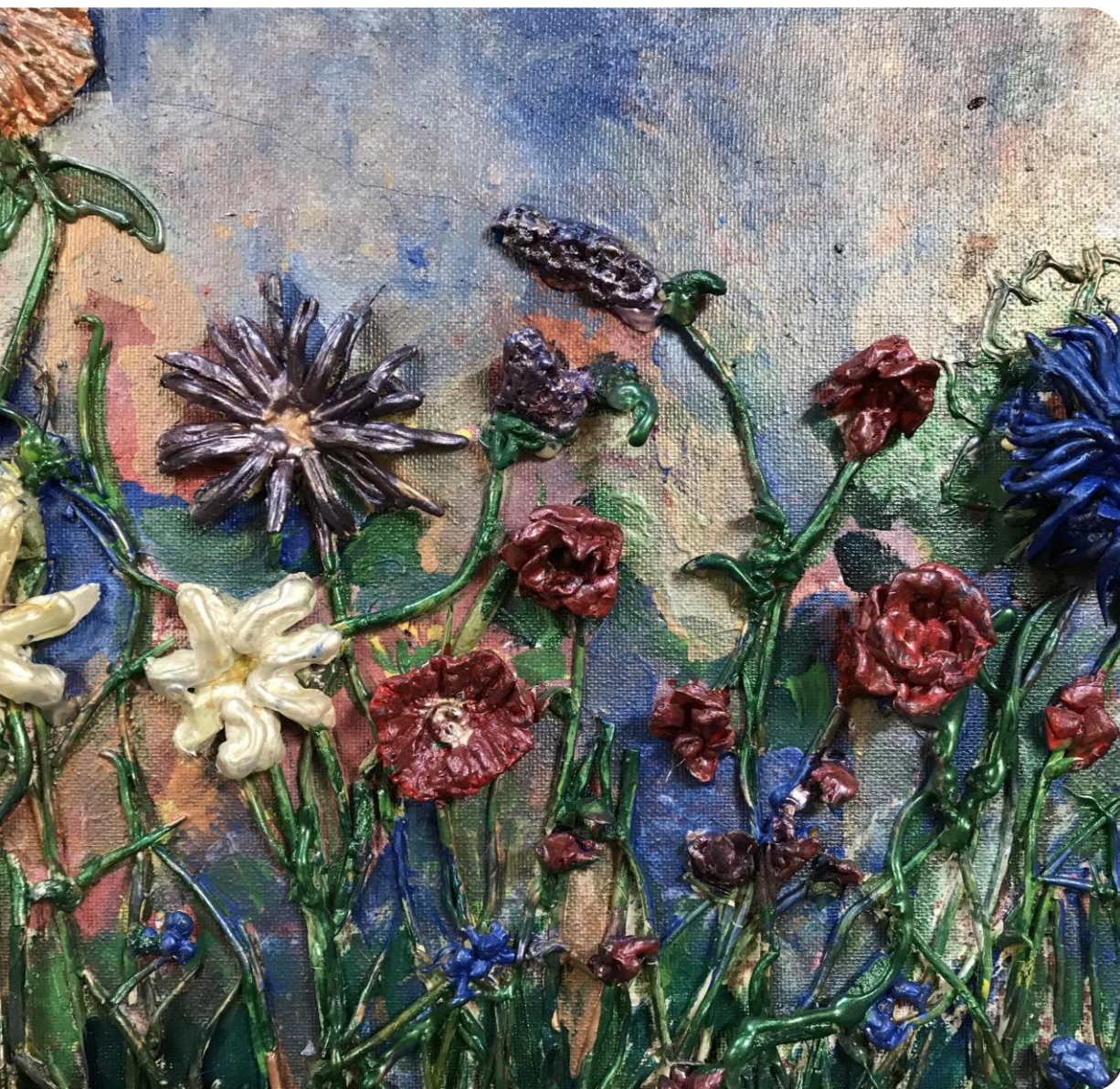
The waiting area is a safe place.
